

# Set TX-Power 30

Three easy steps:

## Here it goes

```
root@kali:~# ifconfig wlan1 down
root@kali:~# iw reg set B0
root@kali:~# iwconfig wlan1 txpower 30
```

## This is what it looks before

```

```

Power Management: off
```

mine is `wlan1` as internal is wlan0 yours may well be `wlan0` so just swap `wlan1` for `wlan0` in your own setup.
