

Set TX-Power 30

Three easy steps:

Here it goes

```
root@kali:~# ifconfig wlan1 down
root@kali:~# iw reg set B0
root@kali:~# iwconfig wlan1 txpower 30
```

This is what it looks before

mine is wlan1 as internal is wlan0 yours may well be wlan0 so just swap wlan1 for wlan0 in your own setup.

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
