

install ffmpeg

```
apt-get install ffmpeg
```

Convert .wav file to mp3

```
ffmpeg -i track01.wav -acodec mp3 track01.mp3
```

You can also specify the bitrate of the MP3 with the -ab flag.

```
ffmpeg -i track01.wav -acodec mp3 -ab 64k track01.mp3
```

Convert a folder full of .wav into .mp3

```
for i in *.wav; do ffmpeg -i "$i" -acodec mp3 -ab 64k "${basename "$i" .wav}.mp3 ; done
```
